1. 3.5 GPA for grades 7 and 8 (copy of grade 7 and 8 report cards)
2. List of Christian and Community Service
3. 400 word essay covering importance of building good character; why the learning process is important in my life; and how my belief in God helps me live a happy and productive life.

Reverend Victor F. Ries Scholarship

1. 3.7 GPA for Grades 7 and 8 (copy of grades 7 and 8 report cards)
2. Copies of Terra Nova and Iowa Scores (St. Brigid has already sent these scores to Carroll High School)
3. List of Christian and Community Service
