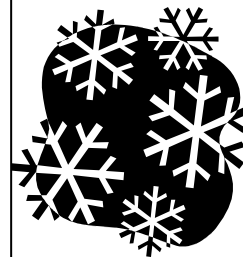

**** Please remember to wear sneakers on Tuesday and Thursday.**

Just a reminder - Our handbook states that "leather shoes or tennis shoes must be worn." Therefore, NO boots of any kind may be worn in the school building. Outerwear boots may be worn to school, but the students must bring regulation-style footwear for inside use.

Language Arts:

- Interpret pictures, make predictions, engage in shared reading
- Express ideas through drawing and writing
- Write sentences beginning up uppercase letters and ending with periods
- Leave spaces between words when writing
- Exploring the letter O – talking about the sound it makes, how to write it, and what begins with that letter
- Introducing sight word: there
- Review sight words: at, are, my, like, in, put, will, for, and, fun, it, is, can, give, see, was, gave, play

Religion: Ch. 14 – Jesus Blesses the Children

- Explain that Jesus invited the children to come to him
- Encourage to pray to Jesus
- Explain what it means to listen to Jesus
- Demonstrate praying to Jesus

Math:

- Calendar skills - day, week, month, year, counting, patterns
- Counting by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's
- Discovering relationships between different quantities
- Exploring the possible arrangements for a given number
- Model and represent addition as combining sets and counting on, and subtraction as take-away and comparison
