Official Patron Saint Report

The written portion of this report consists of three good paragraphs and an illustration. Each paragraph is a minimum of five sentences. Each paragraph must go through the entire writing process (notes, draft, revised, edited, teacher approval and final copy). I will teach the students how to take notes and provide resources. Time will be given in school to work on this report. Each student must choose a different saint.

Paragraph One: tell your full name and the story of how you got your name.

Paragraph Two: will tell the name of your patron saint and teach others about the most important things in his/her life. When? Where? What? Why? How? Etc.

Paragraph Three: will tell how your patron saint is a role model for you
