## Sixth Grade Religion Prophet Project

Students will work in pairs to create a PowerPoint Presentation on one of the Prophets of the Old Testament.

### The PowerPoint must contain:

1. A title slide containing the name of the prophet and the students participating.
2. A slide answering at least five of the following questions:
  - a. How was this prophet called by God?
  - b. When did this prophet preach?
  - c. Where did this prophet preach?
  - d. Why did this prophet preach?
  - e. What was this prophet's message?
  - f. To whom did this prophet preach?
  - g. What are some of the images this prophet uses?
  - h. How did the people respond to this prophet?
3. Students must include at least two related images in their PowerPoint.
4. Students must include a slide listing all the resources used.
5. Students must give a 3-5 minute oral presentation to the class.

### General guidelines:

- No sounds or special effects may be used.
- Students must present the teacher with one printed copy of their slides on \_\_\_\_\_ the day the project is due.
- Each student must turn in this sheet, with the back filled out.
- Students will be graded individually.
- All questions must be answered in complete sentences.
- The project is worth 50 points.
- ALL students will be given ample time to work in class. Please use this time wisely.
